- Many of us grew up thinking of the Bible's commands as a list of rules to follow. How would it change things to view them instead as a picture of the kind of life you will naturally lead as God transforms you from the inside out?
- Who do you have in your life who knows what is really going on inside of you? Do you think it's important to have relationships like that? Why or why not?
- How can you help Redeemer continue to become a place where it is safe for people to open up about their struggles so that God can work in their lives?

Some next steps: Here are some things you can do this week to allow God to keep pulling your life:

- Oswald Chambers said that "the Sermon on the Mount is a statement of the life we will live when the Holy Spirit is getting his way with us." This week re-read the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7) and take some time to consider the following questions:
 - What is God saying to you as you read?
 - What are the areas of your life where the Holy Spirit needs to "get his way with you"?
 - What practical steps could you take to help that process?
