

The Journey of Faith: A Walk to Emmaus

Luke 24

Today we continue in the joy of the Resurrection by learning from two travelers on their way to the village of Emmaus (about seven miles from Jerusalem) soon after the discovery of the Empty Tomb. Woven into this account are three essential *steps of faith* for everyone:

Luke 24: 13-27 ***Notitia***

“*Notitia* refers to the _____ of faith, or those things that we believe. We place our faith in something, or more appropriately, _____. In order to believe, we must know something about that someone, who is the _____.

Luke 24: 28-32 ***Assensus***

“*Assensus* is our _____ that the content of our faith is _____. You can know about the Christian faith and yet believe it is not true. _____ says that the content – the *notitia* taught by the Holy Scripture – is true.”

Luke 24: 33-35 ***Fiducia***

“*Fiducia* refers to personal _____ and _____. Knowing and believing the content of the Christian faith are not enough, for even _____ can do that (James 2:19). Faith is only _____ if, knowing about and assenting to the claim of Jesus, one _____ trusts in Him alone for salvation.”
