TALK IT OVER . . .

Talking through the ideas presented in Sunday's message helps us apply God's word to our individual lives. These questions are designed to help you put His words into action in your life this week. Our hope is that as you talk these over with family and friends, the discussion will equip you to more effectively communicate the love of Christ to others.

- Read the book of Colossians at least three times this week. As Joe said, it is short. See if anything “jumps out” at you.
- Describe “diligent” praying. (Be realistic-don't set up an impossible task.) Determine whether or not you are a “diligent prayer person”. If so, keep going. If not, try it for a day or two and see what happens.
- Joe pointed out that everybody is important in making Christ known to the world. What do think your role is?
- As you look back on your week, have you passed up some opportunities to be a “responsive evangelist”? What were they? How can you manage that differently next week?
- Pray for the church and the search committee for at least one minute every day this week.
